What is RPM?

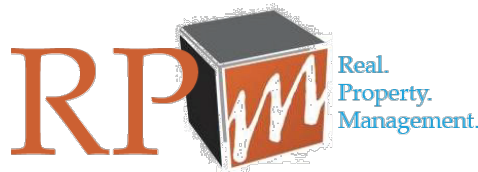
RPM is a comprehensive logistics management system capable of tracking, inspection and life cycle management of any type of commodity or equipment. The application has enhanced capabilities for tracking critical shelf and service life data on time sensitive assets. RPM is an offspring of our Department of Defense program MICAS which has proven itself for over ten years tracking and maintaining critical protective equipment keeping our deployed forces safe around the world. Whether you have the need to monitor individual assets or component systems RPM will keep your inventory current, accurate and ready to go.

Asset Management

This tool can be used by specifying item type or item description to give the searcher more flexibility. By using bar code technology, RPM can track to the item level to accurately keep your assets accountable. With the ability to serialize numbers, items are organized in a more efficient way and in turn are much easier to categorize. These features result in total asset visibility for your assets.

System Configuration Options

RPM is designed to be used in multiple work environments. For this reason, RPM has been designed to work both as a centralized program on a network or system or as a stand-alone tool with roll-up capabilities. These system configurations allow users multiple layers of access at the company, organization, division, and section levels. RPM is also fully customizable- with adjustable display, file storage locations, and hardware settings.



Shelf-Life Management

RPM is also a useful tool to management the shelf life of your assets. With this tool, there is complete visibility of assets and/or warranties that are about to expire. These warnings are color coded for notification at the 3-month, 6-month, and 12-month windows. This system allows FIFO use of your oldest assets. Forget to pull an expired asset off the shelves?

No problem, RPM will prompt you of an assets' status when an individual attempts to use assets on the warning list.

Shipment and Receipt of Assets

By centralizing your asset database, RPM allows for visibility of assets upon ownership change. This system allows the user to reconcile differences on the receiving end for the most accurate record keeping. The stand-alone capabilities of RPM are highlighted in the shipment and receipt of assets because reports such as the Advanced Shipment Notice (ASN) of the manifest can be used. By using bar code technology, RPM can build unique and accurate shipments.

Issue and Return

Beyond the tracking of assets shipped or soon to be received, RPM tracks the issue and return of items released to personnel. With the receipt system in place, RPM users can track the expected return date of specific items to ensure complete visibility and efficiency.
